



2012 Dog License

The 2012 dog licenses are now available for you to purchase for your dog. Dogs living within the City of Meridian that are over 6-months old must be licensed each calendar year. Dog licensing ensures that dogs living within the City are rabies vaccinated and also enables Animal Control Officers to reunite dogs with their owners in a timely manner if they are found loose.

The items you will need to obtain your dog's license are:

- Check or Money Order for the appropriate amount.
- Proof of rabies vaccination with a copy of a shot record and/or receipt from the veterinarian.
- Proof of spay/neuter (if applicable) with a copy of a receipt for the procedure and/or documentation from a veterinarian.

License Fees Per Dog

\$16.00—Spay or Neutered (must include proof)

\$21.00—Non-Spay or Non-Neutered
